# Rules of the Fair

1. Thursday, August 24, 2023, will be Entry Day from 12 noon until 8:00 pm. Exhibitors MUST be wearing a wrist band. Children under the age of 12 NOT entering may enter the building free. Fair admission at the gate will be \$2.50 per wrist and, but wrist bands purchased before the fair will be \$2.00 The wrist band is good for all 3 days of the fair.

2. Junior Exhibitors are 16 years of age and under.

3. Exhibitors must fill out entry blanks and bring them with their entries to the Entry Desk. You can print the entry blank on this web site.

4. Please print the entries so that they are readable. The Entry Form must have the exhibitors name, complete address, and phone number.

5. There will be no traffic allowed in the exhibit hall while exhibits are being set up on Thursday night.

6. Each entry tag must be securely attached to the entry itself or receptacle in which it is shown.

7. All entries made past 2 years /produced/finished, or grown within the past year, and not previously exhibited, except for potted plants.

8. Only one entry per exhibitor per lot.

9. Exhibitors may be residents of Minnesota, or adjoining counties.

10. All entries must be in the name of the grower or owner, and have been made/raised by exhibitor, except flower arrangement materials—they can be bought, borrowed or collected in the wild.

11. Judging will begin at 8:00 am on Friday, August 25. The exhibit hall will be closed during that time, and open at about 1:00 pm. The exhibit hall will be closed at 7:30 pm.

12. Any attempt to influence the judges will be cause for excluding the exhibit in question from competition.

13. Articles not listed in the premium book may be entered "For Display Only" and not be part of the competition.

14. All entries may be removed between 6:00 pm and 7:00 pm Sunday evening. Premiums will not be paid for exhibits removed early.

15. Premium checks must be cashed within 30 days of issuance. Errors must be reported within 5 days.

## SWEEPSTAKES RIBBONS

are awarded to the exhibitor with the most points in each division: Domestic Arts, Horticulture Arts, and Creative Arts.

The point system is based on the following:

2 points for Division Champion

5 points for 1st place ribbon

3 points for 2nd place ribbon

1 point for 3rd place ribbon

The three Sweepstakes winners will also receive a \$20.00 cash prize.

1. Canned goods exhibited in pint jars or quarts.
2. Canned goods will be opened at option of judge when competition is close.
3. All jars including jams & jellies to have metal ring and lid (paraffin seals allowed for jams/ jellies, with ring and lid). The reason for rings and lids is to keep the flies out and exhibit from spilling. Vinegar jars with screw lid and lid not needed to be sealed like other canning. Amount of liquid about 1-2 cups in clear glass container.
4. Jelly, Jam & Marmalade may be in jars smaller than pints.
5. If using pectin in jelly, so indicate with date.

2. No frosting on shortening cakes Lots 1-12a; except Lot 6, which is a decorated cake and can be on a cardboard box.

3. Cookies and Bars, 3 of equal size for display on paper plates in plastic bags. We have separate divisions for pressed and rolled types regardless of flavor: Cup Cakes, 3 of equal size.

4. Pies, pot pie tins may be used. No cream pies can be accepted due to spoilage- we do not have refrigerated space.

5. Homemade candy, display 3 of equal size on plate in plastic bag.
